**(Lawrence Campus)**

- Since 2005, the Center for Service Learning has created and supported a variety of experiential learning opportunities for students. In total, over 350 students in 30 majors and four graduate programs have been certified in service learning impacting 43 community based organizations and partnering with them over 5,725 hours.
- According to data compiled by KU's [Center for Service Learning](#), approximately 6,070 students participated in community service projects during the 2006-07 academic year providing over 100,650 hours of service to the community. More than half of those students contributed 20 hours or more to their projects.
- During the 2006-2007 year, over 1,700 students participated in academic service learning with the intent of applying their academic knowledge to meet specified community needs.
